Be a part of the largest assessment-focused community event in Europe, at the 2024 E-ATP Conference. This year's theme is **E-ATP: The European Home of Assessment** with a subtheme focusing on *Assessing Tomorrow: Shaping the Future together*.

Join us in Berlin, Germany where we aim to redefine our connection with assessment. As Europe's leading forum for assessment expertise, E-ATP connects a global community of innovators and experts, making it a pivotal event for those at the forefront of educational and professional testing.

At this year's conference, we're focused on integrating the human element into the ever-evolving landscape of assessment technology. Our goal is to ensure that advancements in testing are innovative and guided by empathy and inclusivity. This approach champions assessments that are fair, accessible, and human-centered. Submit a presentation to share your perspective, evidence, and visions at the 2024 E-ATP conference on 23 - 25 October, 2024.

In Berlin, let's come together to shape a future that values people just as much as progress.

The conference will be held in Berlin, Germany at the Hilton Berlin.

E-ATP Conference topics will include:

- **Assessment Industry Transformation:** Many aspects of testing are undergoing transformations both small and large. Sessions on this topic will discuss features of transformative assessment including design, development, delivery, and maintenance.
- **Evolving Candidate Needs:** Globally, candidate expectations are becoming more complex. Share strategies for customising assessments, feedback, and learning support that align with industry needs.
- **Innovation in Assessment:** Disruptive technologies and emerging techniques are presenting both a threat and an opportunity to the testing industry. Submit a session showing how these innovations are going to reshape the future of assessment from all perspectives.
- **Sharing Your Journey:** Everyone has an interesting journey to share. Highlight something interesting, impactful, or innovative that you or your clients/teams have accomplished. Provide practical guidance, lessons learned, and insights that can benefit future assessment programs. If you feel your story doesn't fit within the other topics, this is the perfect opportunity to contribute your unique perspective.



Guidance to submitters:

- Papers should speak to the conference theme described above.
- All submissions should speak to the European context. Lessons learned from other geographies are welcomed in the learning they offer to Europe, but they must be framed and articulated for a European audience.
- Preference will be given to the following:
 - Case study presentations.
 - Client Presentations or Vendor co-presentations with clients or user organisations.

Acceptance Limitations:

- A maximum of **three sessions per company** are permitted at the conference, and a **maximum of two sessions** per presenter are permitted. Sponsor Sessions are not included in this count.

Requirements:

- Presenters are expected to register for the conference at the conference rate at the time of registration, book and pay for their hotel room, and to provide their own laptop for the presentation. You are also responsible for arranging travel and transportation to and from the conference.

Session Types are defined as follows:

- **Presentations** - Presentations are 45-minute presentations or panel discussions consisting of 30 minutes of content and 15 minutes of live Q&A. Presentations provide a rounded perspective on a topic. Sessions can include multiple presenters from a single organisation or multiple organisations. One 45-minute presentation could include multiple smaller presentations around the same topic.
- **Interactive Sessions** – Interactive Sessions are 45-minute sessions involving debate, discussions, or group activities to engage and involve the audience. These sessions should promote a high level of audience engagement and involvement throughout the entirety of the session.

Selection of Topic Addressed:

You must select the primary topic that your submission addresses. The E-ATP 2024 Conference Committee may alter this as they review and finalise sessions.

- **Assessment Industry Transformation**
- **Evolving Candidate Needs**
- **Innovation in Assessment**
- **Sharing Your Journey**

Note: Presentation authors are reminded that submissions addressing the above topics should speak to the European context and if the subject matter is referencing other geographies, the learning offered to Europe



should be clear and papers must be framed and articulated for a European audience.

Submission Reminders

- A maximum of **three sessions per company** are permitted at the conference, and a maximum of **two sessions per presenter** are permitted. Sponsor Sessions are not included in this count.
- If submitting a presentation session that includes multiple smaller presentations around the same topic, please include the different presentation details in the abstract when submitting. This includes titles and descriptions for each presentation.
- Presenters must register and pay the registration fee to attend the conference. All speakers are responsible for all costs associated with travel and hotel stay.
- Submissions judged by E-ATP reviewers to be simply advertisements for products and services or overly promotional in nature will likely not be accepted.
- Preference will be given to the following: Case study presentations and Client Presentations or Vendor co-presentations with clients or user organisations.
- E-ATP reserves the right to combine session proposals and/or change session types, in order to balance the number of sessions accepted.
- E-ATP may edit session titles and abstracts for marketing purposes.
- It will not be possible to guarantee a particular day and time for any presentation. All presenters must attend the Conference on the assigned day of their presentation.
